- ▶ Read drawings, work orders and production schedules to determine product or job instructions and specifications;
- ▶ Examine work for defects, and measure with straightedges or templates to ensure conformance with specifications;
- ▶ Set up and operate hand and power tools common to the welding trade such as shielded metal arc and gas metal arc welding equipment, grinders and carbon rod gauging;
- ▶ Detect faulty operation of equipment and/or defective materials or products and notify supervisors;
- ▶ Perform physical labouring tasks associated with welding work such as lifting and adjusting heavy objects, and cleaning up work site;
- ▶ Safe and effective operation and maintenance of assigned tools, plant and equipment associated with the job using required Personal Protective Equipment;
- ▶ Keep records of jobs;
