### RESPONSIBILITIES

- 🔦 Remove scrub, timber, rocks and other foreign material to clear and level sites;
- 🔦 Digs holes for footings, spread and level soil, gravel and sand on roads and driveways, trench bottoms and similar locations;
- 🔦 Load and unload buildings and construction materials, tools and equipment;
- 🔦 Perform building and installation work;
- 🔦 Erect and dismantles temporary structures such as barricades and scaffolding around work sites;
- 🔦 Undertake basic concrete work and form work as needed;
- 🔦 Install door handles, locks, hardware, flooring underlay, suspended ceilings, insulating materials and other fixtures as needed;
- 🔦 Collect and remove rubble and waste material from sites;
- 🔦 Other duties as directed.

- 🔦 Certificate III in Carpentry, or equivalent trade certificate and 1 years' experience in similar role;
